



- **In the late 1990's, a remand was undertaken of the State of California Supreme Court case Aikens vs. State of California. The subject of that landmark case was massive flooding in the Sacramento, California area.**



- **The analysis of causation factors included studies of dams, rivers, levees, soil-water flow, sediment transport, storm analysis, among other factors. Of key concern was the issue of whether the property was subject to historic flooding.**
